CITY OF YOUNGSTOWN PLANS CULVERT REPLACEMENT ON ELLA AVENUE

MAH-ELLA AVENUE PID: 99867

The City of Youngstown is proposing the removal of the existing concrete/metal pipe culvert crossing Sugar Creek on the central portion of Ella Avenue. The culvert will be replaced with a new precast concrete arch with new wingwalls and rock channel protection. The proposed improvements will also include embankment reconstruction, pavement replacement, and the installation of guardrail. The proposed improvements will be constructed on land owned by the City of Youngstown.

The proposed project will not impact any cultural resources, or result in substantial impacts to ecological resources. The project will not result in substantial impacts to the environment either individually or cumulatively.

The transportation improvement is scheduled for construction in 2018. The \$2.5 million project is expected to be completed within one construction season. Traffic will be maintained during construction. Access to all properties within the construction limits will be maintained at all times during construction of the project.

Additionally, in compliance with Section 106 of the National Historic Preservation Act of 1966, as amended (codified as 36 CFR 800), ODOT also requests information regarding the presence of any known cultural resources in the vicinity of the project. Cultural Resources include prehistoric and historic archaeological sites, historic bridges, historic buildings, sites and districts.
