- ORD-26-91 4. Authorizing the Board of Control of the City of Youngstown to approve a blanket purchase order for calendar year 2026, not to exceed \$50,000.00 for JP's Automotive Services LLC to continue to provide mechanic services and NFPA Compliance of the Fire Department Fleet.
