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| ORD-24-79 | 1. | Authorizing the Board of Control of the City of Youngstown to approve a blanket purchase order for Bell Equipment, in an amount not to exceed \$455,000.00 for Calendar Year 2024, for the purchase of one (1) 33-yard Heil Duarpack Python Automated Side Loader – Eject Sanitation Truck, including all standard equipment and quoted options. |
| ORD-24-80 | 2. | Authorizing the Board of Control of the City of Youngstown to waive the formal bidding process, pursuant to Section 735.051 of the Ohio Revised Code, and make payment to Schindler Elevator Corp. in the amount of \$96,535.00, through the Sourcewell Cooperative Purchasing Program, for replacement of the Youngstown Police Department elevator doors. |
| ORD-24-81 | 3. | Authorizing the Board of Control of the City of Youngstown to enter into a professional services agreement for architectural design services and preparation of bid documents for the City Hall renovations – Second Floor Build-Out Project. Total cost of the project will not exceed \$41,200.00. |

- ORD-24-95 17. **American Rescue Plan:** Authorizing the allocation of American Rescue Plan (ARP) Funds for the Fifth Ward, in an amount not to exceed \$15,000.00, for specific ward projects in accordance with Ordinance 22-103, as passed by Youngstown City Council on April 6, 2022, for the purchase of single-purpose, explosive detection K9, and 6-week handler course at Shallow Creek Kennels.

- ORD-24-62 **American Rescue Plan**: Appropriating \$3,000,000.00 under the American Rescue Plan (ARP) Fund 2701.30_5828, pursuant to U.S. Department of the Treasury guidance on using American Rescue Plan (ARP) funds to address improved public health and negative economic impacts, to pay a vendor, or vendors, to engage in architectural design services for the City of Youngstown Safety Campus. Authorizing the Board of Control of the City of Youngstown to approve and enter into contractual agreements necessary to effectuate the goals for design of the City of Youngstown Safety Campus. Total cost will not exceed \$3,000,000.00.
