MAYOR BROWN:

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| ORD-21-374 | 1. | To adopt and approve the appropriation of the Year 2022 Temporary Operating Budget contained in Exhibit "A", hereto attached and made a part hereof. |
| ORD-21-375 | 2. | Authorizing the Board of Control of the City of Youngstown to advertise for bids and enter into a contract with the lowest and best bidder for the Crescent Street Roadway Improvements Project. Total cost of the project will not exceed \$700,000.00. |
| ORD-21-376 | 3. | Authorizing the Board of Control of the City of Youngstown to waive formal bidding pursuant to Section 735.051 of the Ohio Revised Code, and make payment in the amount of \$46,819.63 to Foust Construction, Inc., 1700 Wilson Avenue, Girard, Ohio 44420, for emergency repairs to the north and south approach slabs of Structure 1 Center Street Bridge, as well as curbing and roadway repairs on Bennington Avenue near East High School. |

Authorizing the acceptance of the Ohio Department of Development, Abandoned Gas Station Cleanup Grant in the amount of \$212,750.00, attached and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof. Grant will be used for assessment, demolition, restoration and remediation of underground tanks at the former gas station located at 1395 Wick Avenue, Youngstown, OH 44505.
- ORD-21-382 9. Appropriating \$212,750.00 to the CPED Project Expense Fund 1001.19_5823, provided by the Ohio Department of Development, Abandoned Gas Station Cleanup Grant Program, attached and incorporated herein as Exhibit "A" and made a part hereof.
