**REMARKS**

**COUNCILWOMAN DAVIS** STATED THAT SHE WILL SUPPORT THIS AMENDMENT WITH THE UNDERSTANDING THAT OPTIONS WERE GIVEN TO COUNCILMEMBERS SUCH AS (1) LEAVING THE FIRE DEPARTMENT WHERE IT'S AT AND ONLY RELOCATING THE POLICE DEPARTMENT; OR (2) RELOCATING THE FIRE DEPARTMENT TO THE PROPOSED FACILITY; BUT SHE WOULD LIKE TO ADD A THIRD: (3) KEEPING THE POLICE DEPARTMENT WHERE IT'S AT BUT BUILDING A NEW POLICE STATION, WHILE LOOKING AT THE FOOTPRINT OF THE CURRENT POLICE STATION. SHE SUPPORTS THE AMENDMENT, BUT DOES NOT SUPPORT MOVING THE POLICE STATION TO WICK AVENUE.

**COUNCILMAN HUGHES** STATED THAT IS COUNCILWOMAN DAVIS' OPINION, NOT

COUNCIL AS A WHOLE.

THE AMENDED ORDINANCE WAS THEN PLACED BEFORE COUNCIL AND PASSED BY A VOTE OF YEAS, 7. NAYS, NONE.

THE ORDINANCE WAS THEN PLACED BEFORE COUNCIL AND PASSED BY A VOTE OF YEAS, 5. NAYS, 2.

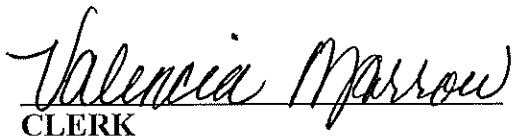
