MS. BISHOP ANSWERED THAT THEY ARE ELIGIBLE AND JUST NEED TO REGISTER AS IT IS OPEN TO THE PUBLIC, WITH THE GOAL BEING TO GET ALL OHIOANS VACCINATED.

COUNCILWOMAN ADAMCZAK ADVISED THAT COUNCILMAN OLIVER WAS HAVING TECHNICAL DIFFICULTIES AND ASKED HER TO RELAY HIS THANKS TO EVERYONE FOR THEIR SUPPORT OF THE CROWN ACT LEGISLATION.
