THIS AMENDMENT BEING TO INCREASE AVAILABLE FUNDS FROM THE OHIO PUBLIC WORKS COMMISSION AND PUBLIC WORKS CAPITAL PROJECTS CODE 4102.30_5804 FROM \$1,250,000.00 TO \$1,450,000.00; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE IF IT RECEIVES THE AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF SIX MEMBERS OF COUNCIL; OTHERWISE, IT SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BE IN FORCE FROM AND AFTER THE

ORD-22-86 AMENDING SECTION 1 OF ORDINANCE NO. 21-73, PASSED BY YOUNGSTOWN CITY COUNCIL ON MARCH 17, 2021, WHICH ESTABLISHED THE MASTER SALARY ORDINANCE FOR THE CITY OF YOUNGSTOWN. 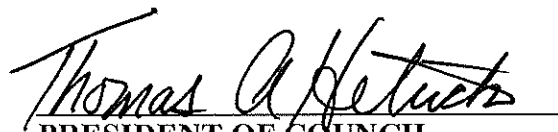
