ORDINANCE

ORD-22-52 AMENDING ORDINANCE NO. 14-275, PASSED IN CITY COUNCIL ON AUGUST 20, 2014, WHICH REDISTRICTED THE CITY OF YOUNGSTOWN INTO SEVEN WARDS, PURSUANT TO SECTION 83 OF THE CHARTER OF THE CITY OF YOUNGSTOWN, AMENDING SECTION 105.01 OF THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF YOUNGSTOWN. THE AMENDMENT BEING: TO ADOPT NEW BOUNDARY LINES OF CITY WARDS, AS HEREINAFTER DESCRIBED IN SECTION 2 AND SECTION 3 AND ILLUSTRATED IN THE ATTACHED MAP MARKED EXHIBIT "A"; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE IF IT RECEIVES THE AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF SIX MEMBERS OF COUNCIL; OTHERWISE, IT SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BE IN FORCE FROM AND AFTER THE EARLIEST PERIOD ALLOWED BY LAW. WAS READ THE FIRST TIME AND UPON MOTION OF MR. RAY THE RULES OF COUNCIL WERE SUSPENDED BY A VOTE OF YEAS, 7. NAYS, NONE.

REMARKS

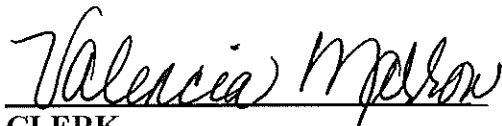
COUNCILMAN RAY NOTED THAT THERE IS A REPLACEMENT PAGE 10, SO THAT SECTION 4 MATCHES VERSION 7 OF THE MAP. SECTION 4 SHOULD READ: FIRST WARD CONTAINS 8,684 INHABITANTS; SECOND WARD 8,856 INHABITANTS; THIRD WARD 8,770 INHABITANTS, FOURTH WARD 8,826 INHABITANTS, FIFTH WARD 8,335 INHABITANTS; SIXTH WARD 8,197 INHABITANTS; AND THE SEVENTH WARD CONTAINS 8,400 INHABITANTS.

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THE ORDINANCE WAS THEN PLACED BEFORE COUNCIL AND PASSED BY A
VOTE OF YEAS, 7. NAYS, NONE.
