### **REMARKS**

HE EXPRESSED HIS CONCERN AND WOULD LIKE TO SEE A RESOLUTION TO URGE THE E.P.A. TO THOROUGHLY VET THE SOBE COMPANY.

**COUNCILWOMAN DAVIS** STATED THERE WAS A RESOLUTION CONCERNING POWER FUTURE OHIO LAST SUMMER, AND IF THEY DID A RESOLUTION REGARDING S.O.B.E. IT WOULD CONTINUE THAT PROCESS. 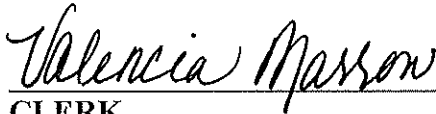

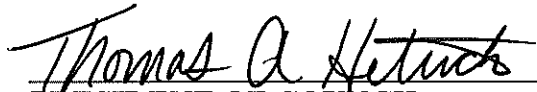
