REMARKS:

COUNCILWOMAN DAVIS REMARKED THAT BECAUSE OF THE TIME CONSTRAINT IN THE FINANCE COMMITTEE MEETING, SHE WASN'T ABLE TO ADDRESS A LOT OF QUESTIONS. SHE QUESTIONS WHETHER MR. VIDALE HAS ANY CONFLICTS OF INTEREST, THE TERMS OF HIS EMPLOYMENT, HOW MUCH WE ARE PAYING HIM, AND THE SERVICES HE IS PROVIDING.

COUNCILWOMAN TURNER NOTED SHE WONDERED IF THERE IS AN ANNUAL PERFORMANCE REVIEW FOR THIS POSITION, BASED ON THE SCOPE OF SERVICES THAT IS OUTLINED IN THE ORIGINAL CONTRACT; AND ALSO WANTED TO KNOW IF THERE IS A PLACE FOR COMMUNITY INPUT, AND IF SO, HOW THE MAYOR DEALT WITH THAT.

MAYOR BROWN RESPONDED THAT IF THERE WERE ALL OF THESE QUESTIONS, HE WOULD HAVE PREFERRED COUNCIL SEND IT TO COMMITTEE TO HAVE THOSE ANSWERED. HE THOUGHT THAT WAS THE ORIGINAL CONVERSATION IN THE

FINANCE COMMITTEE. HE STATED THAT THERE ARE PERFORMANCE EVALUATIONS DONE FOR EACH EVENT THROUGHOUT THE YEAR, AND ALSO INPUT FROM THE COMMUNITY REGARDING PLUSES AND NEGATIVES TO FIGURE OUT HOW TO IMPROVE. HE STATED THAT HE THOUGHT COUNCILWOMAN TURNER'S THIRD QUESTION WAS HOW DO WE SEVER THE AGREEMENT? MAYOR BROWN NOTED IT COULD BE DONE WITH A 30 DAY WRITTEN NOTICE FROM EITHER PARTY.

COUNCILMAN OLIVER REMARKED THAT MR. VIDALE IS IN TOTAL BREACH OF CONTRACT, BECAUSE HE HAS A SCOPE OF SERVICES, AND THOSE 4 SCOPES OF SERVICE HAVE NOT BEEN EXECUTED.

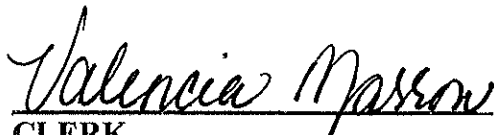
