ORD-19-01 AUTHORIZING THE BOARD OF CONTROL OF THE CITY OF YOUNGSTOWN TO WAIVE FORMAL BIDDING PURSUANT TO SECTION 735.051 OF THE OHIO REVISED CODE, AND MAKE PAYMENT TO MARUCCI AND GAFFNEY EXCAVATING COMPANY IN THE AMOUNT OF \$792,528.02 FOR EMERGENCY REPAIRS TO THE CRAB CREEK OVERFLOW AND SIPHONS; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE IF IT RECEIVES THE AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF SIX MEMBERS OF COUNCIL; OTHERWISE, IT SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BE IN FORCE FROM AND AFTER THE EARLIEST PERIOD ALLOWED BY LAW. FURTHER, APPROPRIATING \$15,198.00 TO THE LITTER PROJECT 07 – SOUTH AVENUE CORRIDOR IMPROVEMENT PROJECT”; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE IF IT RECEIVES THE AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF SIX MEMBERS OF COUNCIL; OTHERWISE, IT SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BE IN FORCE FROM AND AFTER THE EARLIEST PERIOD ALLOWED BY LAW. ORD-19-06 AUTHORIZING THE CITY OF YOUNGSTOWN TO WAIVE THE PROVISIONS OF OHIO REVISED CODE SECTION 4117.14(G)(11) AND EXTEND THE PERIOD FOR THE ISSUANCE OF A FACT FINDING REPORT UNTIL MAY 31, 2019, WITH REGARD TO LABOR NEGOTIATIONS WITH THE YOUNGSTOWN POLICE RANKING OFFICERS (YPRO); AND PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE IF IT RECEIVES THE AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF SIX MEMBERS OF COUNCIL; OTHERWISE, IT SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BE IN FORCE FROM AND AFTER THE EARLIEST PERIOD ALLOWED BY LAW. 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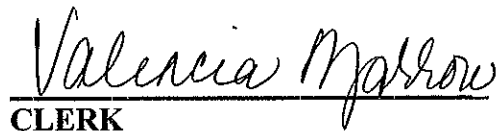
ORD-19-07 AMENDING THE CODIFIED ORDINANCES OF THE CITY OF YOUNGSTOWN: **ENACTING CHAPTER 550, LAND INSTALLMENT CONTRACTS;** AND PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE IF IT RECEIVES THE AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF SIX MEMBERS OF COUNCIL; OTHERWISE, IT SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BE IN FORCE FROM AND AFTER THE EARLIEST PERIOD ALLOWED BY LAW. WAS READ THE FIRST TIME AND UPON MOTION OF MR. PINKARD WAS **MOVED TO THE COMMUNITY, PLANNING AND ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT COMMITTEE.**

ORD-19-08 REPEALING IN ITS ENTIRETY, ORDINANCE 18-283, PASSED BY CITY COUNCIL ON DECEMBER 19, 2018 WHICH AUTHORIZED THE CITY OF YOUNGSTOWN, PURSUANT TO ORC SECTIONS 723.05 AND 723.07, TO PROVIDE FOR THE VACATION OF A PORTION OF EDGAR AVENUE, THE AREA BETWEEN JOSEPHINE AVENUE AND FOREST GLEN AVENUE; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE IF IT RECEIVES THE AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF SIX MEMBERS OF COUNCIL; OTHERWISE, IT SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BE IN FORCE FROM AND AFTER THE EARLIEST PERIOD ALLOWED BY LAW. WAS READ THE FIRST TIME AND UPON MOTION OF MR. PINKARD THE RULES OF COUNCIL WERE SUSPENDED BY A VOTE OF YEAS, 7. NAYS, NONE.
