MR. MIASEK STATED THE ADMINISTRATION HAS BEEN MEETING WITH THE FIRE UNION AND FACTFINDER. THEY HAVE REQUESTED THE REPORT BE ISSUED ON THE 10TH AND WILL REQUIRE THAT THE ADMINISTRATION GIVE COUNCIL ITS RECOMMENDATION OF APPROVAL OR REJECTION. THE ADMINISTRATION HAS SEVEN DAYS TO RESPOND AND WILL REQUEST DURING THE NEXT COUNCIL MEETING JANUARY 17TH COUNCIL TAKE THEIR RECOMMENDATION AND ACT ON IT.

COUNCILWOMAN DAVIS ANNOUNCED A SPECIAL FINANCE COMMITTEE MEETING SCHEDULED FOR JANUARY 11, 2024 AT 4:00 P.M. AND THE TOPIC WILL BE "POLICE OVERTIME".

MR. MIASEK REQUESTED THAT COUNCILWOMAN DAVIS RECONSIDER THE DATE OF THIS MEETING AS HE WILL NOT BE PRESENT JAN. 5- 14TH TO REPRESENT THE ADMINISTRATION AND FINANCE DEPARTMENT.

COUNCILWOMAN TURNER STATED THAT THE POLICE OVERTIME SHOULD BE DISCUSSED DURING BUDGET MEETINGS AND SHOULD ALSO BE A MEETING OF COUNCIL OF THE WHOLE CONVERSATION.

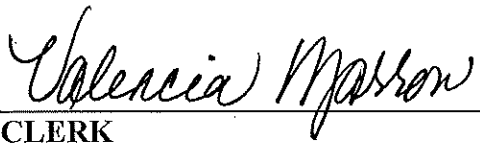
