HEALTH COMMISSIONER ERIN BISHOP STATED THAT SHE CAN'T GIVE A DEFINITIVE ANSWER, BUT THE MAJORITY OF REPORTS SAY THREE DAYS.

BUILDING & GROUNDS SUPERVISOR KEVIN FLINN NOTED THAT HE HAS CREWS AND TRUCKS READY FOR THE IMPENDING SNOW STORM.

PARK DIRECTOR DAWN TURNAGE ANNOUNCED UPCOMING HOLIDAY EVENTS.
