COUNCILWOMAN MCNALLY STATED THE ACTIONS IN THE NATION'S CAPITOL ARE TREASONOUS AND SUGGESTED THE POSSIBILITY OF A RESOLUTION TO SUPPORT CERTIFYING THE NOVEMBER ELECTION RESULTS.

COUNCILWOMAN DAVIS NOTED THAT SHE CARRIES A COPY OF THE CONSTITUTION OF THE UNITED STATES WITH HER, AND WHAT HAS HAPPENED HAS TORN AT HER HEART, AS WE ARE A NATION OF LAW AND DEMOCRACY.

COUNCILWOMAN ADAMCZAK STATED SHE SHARES THE SAME SENTIMENTS AS HER COLLEAGUES.

PRESIDENT KITCHEN ADDED THAT TODAY WILL GO DOWN AS ONE OF THE DARKEST DAYS IN HISTORY.

HEALTH COMMISSIONER ERIN BISHOP GAVE A COVID-19 UPDATE. SHE NOTED THAT TODAY WAS THEIR 5TH DAY OF RUNNING VACCINATION CLINICS. THE HEALTH DEPARTMENT IS IN PHASE 1A OF VACCINATIONS. THEY HAVE BEGUN VACCINATING EMS, FIREFIGHTERS, PEOPLE WITH DEVELOPMENTAL DISABILITIES AND OTHERS IN GROUP HOME SETTINGS. PHASE 1B WILL START IN ABOUT 2

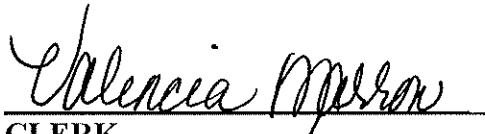
WEEKS. THERE IS A NEW WEBSITE: COVID19.YOUNGSTOWNOHIO.GOV. PEOPLE OVER THE AGE OF 65 CAN SIGN UP ON THAT WEBSITE AND BE SCHEDULED FOR THE FIRST OPEN VACCINATION CLINICS. IN THE NEXT ROUND THEY WILL ALSO VACCINATE IN THE SCHOOLS AND TEACHERS. VACCINATION CLINICS ARE OPEN MONDAY THROUGH FRIDAY 8:00 TO 4:00, AND SHE REQUESTED THAT ANY RN'S THAT WOULD LIKE TO DONATE THEIR TIME TO HELP TO PLEASE REACH OUT, AS THEY ONLY HAVE TWO NURSES.

PRESIDENT KITCHEN ASKED IF THIS IS A TWO-PART VACCINE.

HEALTH COMMISSIONER ERIN BISHOP ANSWERED THAT IT IS THE MODERNA VACCINE AND IT IS TWO-PART; AND YOU HAVE TO WAIT 28 DAYS TO GET THE SECOND SHOT. THAT IS WHY SHE WILL NEED MORE NURSES FOR THE SECOND ROUND.
