**REMARKS**

**COUNCILMAN OLIVER** RESPONDED TO SPEAKER MR. RICHARD FOGO (COM-24-99) AND HIS CONCERNS WITH THE TETHERING LAW NOT BEING ENFORCED. HE NOTED THAT COUNCIL'S SAFETY COMMITTEE IS LOOKING AT CAMPBELL'S TETHERING LAW WHICH MAKES IT ILLEGAL TO TETHER, AS WELL AS WHAT THEY DO WITH STRAY OR FERAL CATS. HE NOTED THEY WANT TO PROTECT THE ANIMALS, BUT DON'T WANT OUR LAWS TO RESTRICT OUR OFFICERS FROM DOING THEIR JOBS.

**COUNCILWOMAN DAVIS** RESPONDED THAT YOUNGSTOWN CITY COUNCIL IS IN SUPPORT OF A RESOLUTION OPPOSING A GAS RATE 30% INCREASE FROM DOMINION ENERGY AS PROPOSED BY SPEAKER WARREN CITY COUNCILMAN MR. GREG GREATHOUSE (COM-24-101).

WAS READ THE FIRST TIME AND UPON MOTION OF MR. RAY **WAS MOVED TO A SECOND READING.**
