REMARKS

COUNCILMAN KELLY: NOTED IT WAS BROUGHT TO HIS ATTENTION THAT A STUDY WAS ALREADY DONE PRIOR TO HIM TAKING OFFICE BY THE INTERNATIONAL UNION, SO HE ASKED THAT IT BE PUT IN COMMITTEE AS HE NEEDED A CHANCE TO READ IT OVER, AND THAT WE DON'T NEED ANOTHER \$50,000 STUDY IF WE ALREADY HAVE ONE IN PLACE.

COUNCILWOMAN DAVIS: STATED THAT SHE WAS NOT SATISFIED WITH THE WAY THIS STUDY WAS DONE. SHE REMINDED COUNCIL, THAT WHEN THEY RELIED ON THE FIRE DEPARTMENT'S EXPERTISE IN THE PAST ON THE RADIO SYSTEM, THEY FOUND OUT IT WAS FLAWED.

REMARKS

COUNCILWOMAN DAVIS: STATED THAT THE LAW DIRECTOR HAS AN INHERENT CONFLICT OF INTEREST, BASED ON HOW THE CITY CHARTER IS WRITTEN. IT STATES THE LAW DIRECTOR SERVES AS LEGAL COUNSEL FOR BOTH CITY COUNCIL AND THE ADMINISTRATION. BUT BY YOUR OWN WORDS, YOU DANCE WITH THE ONE WHO BROUGHT YOU, AND WE DIDN'T BRING YOU IN, THE MAYOR DID. THERE ARE PAPERS WRITTEN ABOUT THE INHERENT CONFLICT OF INTEREST OF LAW DIRECTORS AND OTHER APPOINTEES WHO ARE SERVING AT THE PLEASURE OF THE MAYOR, AS HAS OCCURRED WITH PAST LAW DIRECTORS. WHEN THIS CURRENT MAYOR CAME INTO OFFICE, HE CIRCUMVENTED CITY COUNCIL, BY INITIALLY SPLITTING THE COSTS OF HIS CAR FROM TWO DIFFERENT FUNDS, EVEN THOUGH IT SHOULD HAVE COME OUT OF ONE FUND FOR \$27,000.00, WHICH THEN WOULD HAVE COME THROUGH CITY COUNCIL. SHE STILL WOULD HAVE SUPPORTED IT, AS THE MAYOR DESERVES A CAR. REGARDING THE SAFETY CAMPUS, WHEN YOU SPLIT UP THE \$48,000.00, IN AN ATTEMPT TO CIRCUMVENT US, IT IS THE SAME PROJECT AND WILL SHARE THE SAME WATER LINES. SO IT MAKES ME QUESTION THE LAW DIRECTOR'S INTEGRITY AND LOYALTY, AS CITY COUNCIL HAS TO HAVE FAITH IN THEM AND THE LEGAL ADVICE THEY GIVE. THERE WOULD NEED TO BE A CHARTER CHANGE THOUGH, AS WE NEED A LAW DIRECTOR WHO IS INDEPENDENT OF THE EXECUTIVE SEAT.

COUNCILMAN OLIVER: HE IS IN SUPPORT OF THE SAFETY CAMPUS, BUT HE HAD ISSUES WHEN THE TWO DIFFERENT FUNDS CAME UP AS THAT WAS A RED FLAG TO HIM. HE ALSO STILL WANTS TO SEE SAFETY FORCES REMAIN PRESENT IN THE DOWNTOWN, ESPECIALLY WITH THE GROWTH OF BUSINESSES AND RESTAURANTS.
