REMARKS

COUNCILWOMAN TURNER RESPONDED TO THREE CONSTITUENT SPEAKERS (COM-24-75, COM-24-76, AND COM-24-77) WHO HAVE CHILDREN IN THEIR FAMILIES WITH SENSORY DISABILITIES, REGARDING THEIR CONCERNS WITH IPES PARK. SHE STATED THAT IT SEEMS THEY ARE INTERESTED IN OTHER SPACES WHERE THIS TYPE OF PARK COULD FIT WITHIN THE SEVENTH WARD. SHE WONDERED IF THE YOUNGSTOWN FOUNDATION COULD WORK WITH LOCAL AUTISM SOCIETIES AND SCHOOLS, BUT LOOK AT OTHER PARK LOCATION OPTIONS; AND HAVE THE LEGISLATION AMENDED TO REMOVE THE LANGUAGE THAT IT HAS TO BE AT IPES.

PARK DIRECTOR CLEMATE FRANKLIN NOTED THEY ARE SET ON THIS LOCATION. HE STATED THAT CHILDREN COULD WEAR SENSORY EARMUFFS FOR LOUD NOISES, AS THEY DO AT WALNUT GROVE IN CANFIELD.

COUNCILMAN HUGHES RESPONDED TO THE SPEAKER (COM-24-80) WHO SPOKE OUT AGAINST DOG TETHERING AND THE LACK OF ENFORCEMENT BY THE CITY. COUNCILMAN HUGHES NOTED THAT THE CITY HAS ANOTHER LAYER OF REPORTING THROUGH THE "SEE-CLICK-FIX" APP, AND STATED THEY ARE LOOKING INTO THE SPEAKER'S CONCERNS THROUGH THE SAFETY COMMITTEE.

FOUNDATION ACTS AS A MANAGER OF THE PROGRAM, AND SHE THINKS THEY'LL WORK HARD TO GET IT TO THE FINISH LINE.

REMARKS

COUNCILWOMAN TURNER REPLIED TO PALESTINIAN-AMERICAN COMMUNITY SPEAKERS (COM-24-72, COM-24-73, AND COM-24-74) THAT SHE IS HAPPY TO SUPPORT A RESOLUTION SUPPORTING A CEASE FIRE, BUT ONLY IF IT IS IN PARTNERSHIP WITH SUPPORTING THE JEWISH-AMERICAN COMMUNITY AS WELL. SHE WANTS TO SEE THE NATIONAL AND INTERNATIONAL COMMUNITY WORK TOGETHER TO SAVE LIVES ON BOTH SIDES.

COUNCILWOMAN DAVIS STATED THAT THEY CAN HAVE DIFFERENT OPINIONS, BUT THERE DOES NOT NEED TO BE VIOLENCE OR BULLYING BECAUSE THEY DON'T AGREE, AND ALL PEOPLE SHOULD FEEL SAFE TO SPEAK.

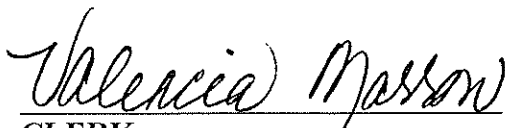
