ORD-21-142 TO ADOPT AND APPROVE THE CITY OF YOUNGSTOWN'S SECOND ANNUAL ACTION PLAN (AAP) YEAR 2021-2022, AS CONTAINED IN EXHIBIT "A", HERETO ATTACHED AND MADE A PART HEREOF; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE IF IT RECEIVES THE AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF SIX MEMBERS OF COUNCIL; OTHERWISE, IT SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BE IN FORCE FROM AND AFTER THE EARLIEST PERIOD ALLOWED BY LAW. WAS READ THE FIRST TIME AND UPON MOTION OF MS. DAVIS THE RULES OF COUNCIL WERE SUSPENDED BY A VOTE OF YEAS, 6. NAYS, NONE.
