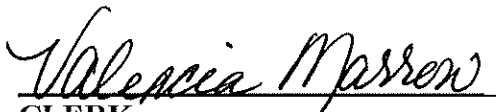

REMARKS

COUNCILWOMAN DAVIS STATED THAT SHE WOULD LIKE TO MAKE A COMMITTEE REPORT. ON FEBRUARY 27, 2020 WE HELD A SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING. FIRE CHIEF BARRY FINLEY GAVE AN UPDATE ON THE #12 FIRE STATION AND THAT NECESSARY STRUCTURAL REPAIRS WOULD BE COMPLETED BY THE END OF THE MONTH. CHIEF FINLEY ALSO REPORTED THAT FIREFIGHTERS WOULD BE DOING ONGOING INSERVICE TRAINING FOR THE REST OF THE YEAR. ADDITIONALLY, THERE WOULD BE 7 FIREFIGHTERS ATTENDING AN EMT CERTIFICATION CLASS THROUGH YSU.

POLICE CHIEF ROBIN LEES PRESENTED THAT HE WOULD LIKE TO LEASE NEW CARS FOR HIS HOMICIDE DETECTIVES, INSTEAD OF PURCHASING USED CARS, AT THE COST OF \$50,000 ANNUALLY THROUGH ENTERPRISE RENT-A-CAR. CHIEF LEES REPORTED THAT THERE ARE 31 TAKE-HOME CARS ASSIGNED TO THE DETECTIVE DIVISION, AND OF THE 31 TAKE-HOME CARS, 27 ARE TAKEN HOME TO HOMES OUTSIDE THE CITY OF YOUNGSTOWN BY THE TRAFFIC INVESTIGATORS, THE COMMUNITY POLICE OFFICERS, CRIME LAB TECHNICIANS, HOMICIDE INVESTIGATORS, AND FAMILY SERVICES MEMBERS. NONE OF THESE TAKE-HOME CARS HAVE ACTIVE ("LIVE") GPS; THEY ONLY HAVE PASSIVE GPS WHICH WORKS SPORADICALLY AT BEST. CHIEF LEES STATED THAT THERE WILL BE 5 NEW POLICE OFFICERS SWORN IN AND A PROMOTION TO DETECTIVE SERGEANT ON MARCH 10, 2020. COUNCILWOMAN DAVIS THOUGHT IT WAS IMPORTANT FOR PEOPLE TO KNOW HOW MANY CARS ARE TAKEN HOME AND WHERE THE CARS GO TO.
