REMARKS

COUNCILWOMAN TURNER RESPONDED TO SPEAKER JOHN R. SWIERZ' OPPOSITION TO A BASKETBALL COURT (COM-24-213), AND INQUIRED AS TO WHETHER THE LYNN PARK IMPROVEMENT STUDY WAS COMMISSIONED BY YNDC.

COUNCILWOMAN WHITE REPLIED THAT A STUDY WAS CONDUCTED IN AUGUST 2022, BUT NOT THAT MANY RESIDENTS WERE SURVEYED AT THAT TIME. SHE ALONG WITH YNDC AND THE 7TH WARD AMBASSADOR THEN WENT OUT AND SURVEYED THE RESIDENTS FURTHER ABOUT PLANS FOR LYNN PARK, AND ONE

OF THE FEATURES THAT THE RESIDENTS SAID WAS NOT IMPORTANT TO THEM WAS A BASKETBALL COURT.

COUNCILWOMAN TURNER ASKED IF TWO SETS OF LINES COULD BE DRAWN FOR PICKLE BALL AND BASKETBALL BUT ON THE SAME COURT.

PARK DIRECTOR CLEMATE FRANKLIN RESPONDED HE COULD LOOK INTO IT.

COUNCILMAN OLIVER ASKED IF THERE WERE RACIAL UNDERTONES ENCOUNTERED IN OPPOSITION TO A BASKETBALL COURT, AS POINTED OUT BY SPEAKER BASIA ADAMCZAK (COM-24-214).

PARK DIRECTOR FRANKLIN AFFIRMED HE IS AWARE OF SOME NEGATIVE RACIAL UNDERTONE SENTIMENT.

COUNCILWOMAN WHITE STATED THERE IS ALREADY A HALF COURT FOR BASKETBALL. SHE STATED SHE IS REPRESENTING HER RESIDENTS AND TAKING INTO ACCOUNT THE WANTS AND NEEDS OF HER CITIZENS WHO LIVE THERE. THE PLANS CREATED A LOT OF UNREST. SHE ALSO MENTIONED THE NEED FOR PARK AMENITIES AT PEMBERTON PARK. SHE WANTS THIS ONCE IN A LIFETIME ALLOTMENT OF FUNDS TO UPDATE OUR PARKS UTILIZED FOR THE RESIDENTS IN HER WARD WITH THE RESIDENTS AND PARK ANALYSIS IN MIND.

COUNCILWOMAN TURNER APPLAUDED THE 7TH WARD CITIZENS AND BLOCK WATCH HEADS FOR COMING OUT TO EXPRESS THEIR CONCERNS, AND SHE ENCOURAGES THE 2022 PARK ANALYSIS STUDY TO BE USED.

COUNCILMAN HUGHES STATED THAT NO ONE TOLD HIM ABOUT THAT PACKAGE AND NO ONE HAS NOTED HIS CONCERNS.

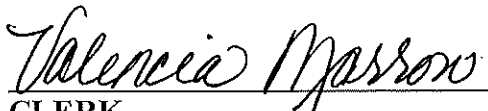
