ADDITIONAL REMARKS:

COUNCILWOMAN MCNALLY NOTED SHE HAD A COUPLE STATEMENTS. LAST NIGHT COUNCIL MET WITH THE FIRE CHIEF AND FINANCE DIRECTOR AND INFORMED COUNCIL THAT THE FIRE DEPARTMENT WAS GOING TO EXCEED THEIR OVERTIME EXPENDITURES. UNFORTUNATELY, THE ADMINISTRATION PRESENTED A FINANCIAL SOLUTION THAT SEEMED INCOMPLETE AND UNSUSTAINABLE IN THE LONG TERM. THE ADMINISTRATION STATED THAT THERE WAS SOME MISMANAGEMENT OF THE BUDGET AS THE FIRE DEPARTMENT DIDN'T FILL A SECRETARIAL POSITION AT THE BEGINNING OF THE YEAR, AND INSTEAD USED A FIREFIGHTER TO FILL THAT POSITION AT FULL FIREFIGHTER PAY, AND THEREFORE HAD TO COVER THE VOID ON THE TRUCK THROUGH OVERTIME. IT IS DISAPPOINTING THAT THE ADMINISTRATION HAS NOT CREATED A SUSTAINABLE PLAN FOR OUR FIRE DEPARTMENT ESPECIALLY AFTER THE MAYOR'S FINANCIAL ADVISER'S ANALYSIS RECOMMENDATIONS ADDRESSED THIS DEPARTMENT SPECIFICALLY, AND KNOWING WE WERE IN THE SAME SITUATION LAST YEAR. A LONG TERM PLAN WOULD AT LEAST GIVE US A LIGHT AT THE END OF THE TUNNEL. COUNCIL MUST BE FISCALLY RESPONSIBLE AND THE ENTIRE ADMINISTRATION MUST MANAGE THEIR BUDGETS IN RESPONSIBLE WAYS ESPECIALLY THIS YEAR.

THE SOLUTION THE ADMINISTRATION PRESENTED TO THE PUBLIC IS BROWNING OUT A FIRE STATION ON A ROTATING BASIS. I PERSONALLY THINK THIS IS A BAD SOLUTION TO A PROBLEM THAT COULD HAVE BEEN AVOIDABLE IN THE FIRST PLACE. IF THE ADMINISTRATION DECIDES TO BROWN OUT ANYTHING, THEY SHOULD BROWN OUT A TRUCK, WHICH WAS THE SOLUTION PRESENTED LAST YEAR TO THE EXACT SAME PROBLEM, THEREBY LEAVING ALL STATIONS OPEN. I BELIEVE THERE ARE ALTERNATIVE SOLUTIONS THAT WERE SHOT DOWN. I HAVE BEEN IN CONTACT WITH LEGISLATORS AT THE STATE LEVEL AND SENATOR SCHIAVONI HAS FORWARDED RESOURCES TO FIND ADDITIONAL FUNDING FOR THE FIRE CHIEF TO REVIEW. THE STATE HAS TAKEN AWAY LOCAL FUNDS AND CONTINUES TO STRIP AWAY MONEY WHICH IMPACTS THE CITY PROVIDING

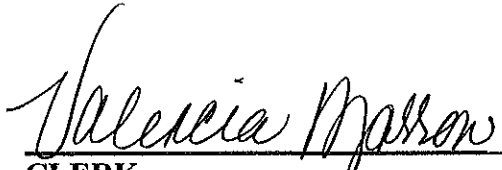
PROGRAMS AND SERVICES. I DO NOT BELIEVE CUTS ARE THE LONG TERM SOLUTION, INSTEAD ECONOMIC DEVELOPMENT IS KEY BY ATTRACTING MORE BUSINESS AND DIVERSIFYING OUR TAX BASE. SHE HOPES THE ADMINISTRATION WILL FIND A BETTER LONG TERM SOLUTION REGARDING THE FIRE DEPARTMENT.

COUNCILWOMAN DAVIS NOTED THAT THE GRASS CUTTING LEGISLATION HAS BEEN SENT TO A THIRD READING IN HOPES THAT THE LAW DEPARTMENT AND MR. DURKIN ARE ABLE TO ADVISE COUNCIL OF THE INSURANCE COVERAGE OF THE CONTRACTORS TO AVOID THE CITY BEING LIABLE FOR SOMEONE ELSE'S MISTAKES.

COUNCILMAN OLIVER URGED THE ADMINISTRATION TO PUT THE KEY PIECES IN PLACE SO THAT THE TAX INCENTIVE REVIEW COUNCIL CAN DO WHAT NEEDS DONE TO EMPLOY THE CITIZENS OF YOUNGSTOWN THROUGH THESE TAX ABATEMENTS.
