COUNCILWOMAN TURNER NOTED THAT SHE WAS THE COUNCILPERSON WHO REQUESTED THE CHANGE TO THE LEGISLATION AS A POINT OF CLARITY. SHE JUST WANTED THE LEGISLATION TO SHOW WHAT WAS SPENT AND WHERE WE ARE MOVING NOW.

COUNCILWOMAN MCNALLY AGREED WITH COUNCILWOMAN DAVIS, AND SHE BELIEVES THE BOARD OF CONTROL ACTIONS ARE ALREADY PUBLIC AND THE ADDED LANGUAGE ISN'T NEEDED.

COUNCILWOMAN ADAMCZAK AGREED WITH COUNCILWOMAN DAVIS.

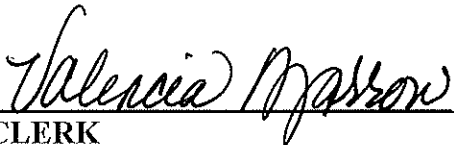
