REMARKS

COUNCILWOMAN TURNER STATED SHE VOTED FOR THE LEGISLATION THE FIRST TIME BECAUSE THERE'S A NEED FOR BETTER COORDINATION OF INFORMATION THAT COMES FROM THE CITY. HOWEVER, OVER THE COURSE OF THE YEAR SHE HAS RECEIVED A HANDFUL OF CORRESPONDENCE AND SOME THAT ARE UNIMPRESSIVE TO THE COMMUNITY OR NOT AT ALL. SHE QUESTIONS WHERE IS THE PUBLIC RELATIONS WORK AND HOW IS IT BEING COMPLETED. DUE TO THE FACT THE INFORMATION HAS NOT BEEN PROVIDED, SHE

CONCLUDES THAT THIS IS NOT THE RIGHT COMPANY TO REPRESENT THE CITY AND TO LOOK ELSEWHERE TO DO THE WORK THAT NEEDS TO BE DONE.

COUNCILMAN OLIVER SAID HE HAS HAD GREAT COMMUNICATION WITH MR. RESNIK WHO IS CURRENTLY WORKING ON INTERVIEWS WITH CITY DEPARTMENT HEADS AND BUSINESS OWNERS TO LET THE COMMUNITY KNOW WHAT IS HAPPENING IN CITY HALL AND CITY COUNCIL.

COUNCILWOMAN DAVIS ASKED IF THE EXPENDITURE IS PREDICATED ON THE PASSAGE OF THE NEXT ORDINANCE.

MR. MIASEK ANSWERED NO. THE EQUIPMENT CAN'T BE ORDERED UNTIL COUNCIL GIVES THE AUTHORITY TO PURCHASE VEHICLES TO PUT THEM IN.

COUNCILWOMAN DAVIS SAID SHE HAD PREVIOUSLY REQUESTED THAT ALL POLICE VEHICLES WITH THE EXCEPTION OF THE UNDERCOVER UNIT VEHICLES, BE EQUIPPED WITH GPS. THE VEHICLES HAVE NOT BEEN EQUIPPED AND IT IS HER UNDERSTANDING THAT IT WILL NOT BE DONE.

COUNCILWOMAN TURNER STATED HER CONCERNS IS THE NUMBER OF CARS THAT ARE CRASHED IN THE PARKING LOT. SHE WOULD LIKE TO KNOW WHAT IS HAPPENING AS THEY PURCHASE A GOOD AMOUNT EVERY YEAR.

COUNCILMAN OLIVER ASKED IF THERE IS A WAY TO REMEDY THIS.

COUNCILWOMAN TURNER ASKED IF THE VEHICLES HAVE BEEN PURCHASED AND THEY ARE ONLY WAITING TO MAKE A PAYMENT BECAUSE THE BUDGET HAS ALREADY BEEN APPROVED.

MR. MIASEK ANSWERED NO, THEY NEED COUNCIL'S AUTHORITY TO MAKE THE PURCHASE.

COUNCILMAN KELLY ASKED IF THIS LEGISLATION COULD BE REVISITED WITH A LOWER NUMBER OF CARS TO PURCHASE.

MR. MIASEK ANSWERED YES, THROUGH FEEDBACK AND DISCUSSION IN A SAFETY COMMITTEE MEETING TO UNDERSTAND COUNCIL'S NEEDS AS WELL AS THE DEPARMENTS NEEDS. THEY CAN PUT TOGETHER A NEW LEGISLATION REQUEST THROUGH ONCE THE DISCUSSION OF UNDERSTANDING HAS BEEN HAD.


