REMARKS

COUNCILMAN RAY ASKED FOR UPDATE ON POLICE ELEVATOR.

BUILDING & GROUNDS DIRECTOR, KEVIN FLINN STATED THAT THE ELEVATOR IS 80-YEARS OLD, NO LONGER ABLE TO BE REPAIRED, THERE WAS A SMALL FIRE IN THE EQUIPMENT ROOM WHICH LEAD TO THE POINT OF HAVING TO REPLACE IT. IT WILL TAKE 12-MONTHS FOR THE DESIGN & PARTS TO ARRIVE THEN 3-MONTHS TO BUILD RESULTING IN A 15-MONTH TIMEFRAME TO REPLACE THE ELEVATOR. THIS IS ABOUT THE SAME TIME TABLE FOR THE ELEVATORS IN CITY HALL & THE ANNEX BUILDINGS WHEN THEY WERE REPLACED.

FINANCE DIRECTOR, KYLE MIASEK ADDED THAT THE CITY WILL NEED TO PAY 50% OF COST UPFRONT.

COUNCILMAN RAY SAID THAT THE BUILDING HAS 6 OR 7 FLOORS AND ASKS WILL ANY ACCOMMODATIONS BE MADE FOR THE EMPLOYEES UNABLE TO TAKE THE STAIRS.

CHIEF DAVIS REPLIED THAT THEY ARE CURRENTLY IN DISCUSSION ABOUT THIS AND LOOKING AT OTHER OPTIONS FOR THE EMPLOYEES MAYBE EVEN "WORKING FROM HOME".

COUNCILMAN OLIVER MENTIONED THAT HE IS BEING TOLD THAT PEOPLE'S PROPERTY IS BEING TAKEN FROM THE REALTY TOWER BUILDING AS IT IS BEING DEMOLISHED. HE ASKS IF THE PEOPLE TAKING ITEMS OUT OF THE BUILDING, ARE THEY CONSTRUCTION WORKERS OR PEOPLE "POSING" AS CONSTRUCTION WORKERS? IF THEY ARE CONSTRUCTION WORKERS IS THE CONSTRUCTION COMPANY BEING HELD LIABLE FOR THE ITEMS THAT ARE BEING TAKEN / STOLEN OUT OF THE BUILDING? DO THE RESIDENTS HAVE TO FILE A POLICE REPORT FOR STOLEN ITEMS? WILL THE CITY INVESTIGATE THE CONSTRUCTION COMPANY?

CHIEF DAVIS STATED THAT CAPTAIN SIMON WHO HEADS UP OUR THE DETECTIVE DIVISION IS CURRENTLY LOOKING INTO ALL THE QUESTIONS THAT YOU JUST ASKED.

MAYOR BROWN ASK THAT MIKE DURKIN EXPLAIN THE PROCESS.

DEMOLITION SUPERVISOR, MIKE DURKIN STATED THAT THE DEMOLITION COMPANY IS IN CHARGE OF THAT AREA NOW AS THE BUILDING OWNER'S HAS HIRED THEM AND THEY HAVE THE SALVAGE RIGHTS TO ANY OF THAT PROPERTY. WHEN A DEMOLITION COMPANY IS HIRED THEY ARE IN CHARGE OF THAT DEMO SITE UNTIL IT IS CLEAN AND GRADED DOWN AND DO TAKE THINGS TO SALVAGE OR TAKE TO THE LANDFILL. TO BE CLEAR THE CITY CAN'T DO IT THAT WAY WE

DON'T SALVAGE ITEMS UPON DEMOING ALL PROPERTY. BUT IN PRIVATE CONTRACTS THIS IS THE PROCESS.

COUNCILMAN RAY AGREED THAT THE TENANTS' PROPERTY SHOULD NOT BE TAKEN.

COUNCILWOMAN DAVIS ASK MAYOR BROWN TO REACH OUT TO THE CONSTRUCTION COMPANY NOT TO TAKE PEOPLE'S PERSONAL ITEMS.
