REMARKS

COUNCILMAN RAY NOTED THAT THE RESOLUTION WAS NOT A PRODUCT OF THE COUNCIL BODY, AND HE WANTED TO WORK WITH HIS COLLEAGUES ON A PIECE BUT WANTS THE WHOLE BODY TO HAVE INPUT.

COUNCILMAN OLIVER STATED HE FELT THE RESOLUTION WAS PUT FORTH IN A DECEITFUL WAY, BUT WOULD PUT FORTH A RESOLUTION THAT REPRESENTS BOTH SIDES.

COUNCILMAN HUGHES NOTED THAT HE IS SUPPORTING THIS RESOLUTION, AS THE MAIN POINTS ARE TO HAVE A CEASE FIRE AND STOP THE WAR.

REMARKS

COUNCILMAN OLIVER THANKED EVERYONE WHO HELPED WITH THE EVACUATION OF INTERNATIONAL TOWERS.

COUNCILWOMAN DAVIS STATED THAT SHE ASKED FOR A LEGAL OPINION ON THE LAW DEPARTMENT REFUSING TO PREPARE LEGISLATION TO REDUCE THE RANKS OF THE YOUNGSTOWN POLICE DEPARTMENT. COUNCIL CREATES AND TAKES POSITIONS OFF THE MASTER SALARY. THE LAW DEPARTMENT STATED IT HAS THE RIGHT TO REFUSE TO PRODUCE THE LEGISLATION THAT COUNCIL REQUESTS, BUT SHE DISAGREES AND STATED THAT THE LAW DEPARTMENT CANNOT REFUSE TO DRAFT SOMETHING. IT IS UP TO COUNCIL WHETHER THEY WANT TO PASS IT, AND THE MAYOR HAS THE OPPORTUNITY TO VETO IT. THE LEGISLATIVE BRANCH CANNOT BE SUBSERVIENT TO THE ADMINISTRATION. IF THE LAW DEPARTMENT WON'T PREPARE THE LEGISLATION THEN IT IS A CONFLICT OF INTEREST, AS THE MAYOR HIRES AND FIRES THE LAWYERS IN THE LAW DEPARTMENT.

COUNCILMAN RAY STATED ALTHOUGH HE DIFFERED ON THE CEASE FIRE RESOLUTION DUE TO PROCEDURAL ISSUES, HE IS COMMITTED TO WORKING ON A NEW PIECE.

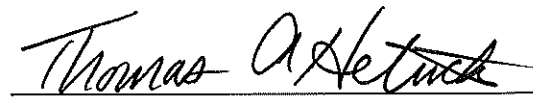
