ORDINANCE

ORD-17-336 AUTHORIZING THE ACCEPTANCE OF THE FEMA SAFER STAFFING GRANT IN THE AMOUNT OF \$398,793.00 AWARDED TO THE YOUNGSTOWN FIRE DEPARTMENT BY FEMA (FEDERAL EMERGENCY MANAGEMENT AGENCY). FURTHER, AUTHORIZING THE BOARD OF CONTROL OF THE CITY OF YOUNGSTOWN TO ENTER INTO ANY NECESSARY CONTRACTS OR AGREEMENTS TO ALLOW THE YOUNGSTOWN FIRE DEPARTMENT TO USE THE GRANT MONIES IN FURTHERANCE OF SAID GRANT; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE IF IT RECEIVES THE AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF SIX MEMBERS OF COUNCIL; OTHERWISE, IT SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BE IN FORCE FROM AND AFTER THE EARLIEST PERIOD ALLOWED BY LAW. WAS READ THE FIRST TIME AND UPON MOTION OF MR. PINKARD THE RULES OF COUNCIL WERE SUSPENDED BY A VOTE OF YEAS, 7. NAYS, NONE.

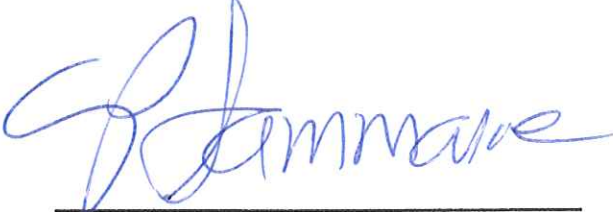
