THE AMENDMENT BEING: **“FOR A MAXIMUM OF TWO (2) COMPLETE CONSECUTIVE TERMS OF FOUR (4) YEARS EACH. A COUNCILPERSON WILL BE ELIGIBLE FOR ELECTION AFTER AN INTERVENING TERM EFFECTIVE JANUARY 1, 2023”**; AND PROVIDING THAT THIS ORDINANCE SHALL BE AN EMERGENCY MEASURE IF IT RECEIVES THE AFFIRMATIVE VOTE OF SIX MEMBERS OF COUNCIL; OTHERWISE, IT SHALL TAKE EFFECT AND BE IN FORCE FROM AND AFTER THE EARLIEST PERIOD ALLOWED BY LAW. REMARKS

COUNCILMAN OLIVER STATED HE IS NOT IN AGREEMENT WITH ORD-22-284 REGARDING LIMITING COUNCILMEMBER TERMS, AND THAT THE POWER OF THE VOTE IS ALREADY IN THE CITIZENS HANDS.

COUNCILMAN HUGHES ASKED FOR CLARITY ON WHETHER IT WAS REQUIRED THAT COUNCIL VOTE YES ON THE CHARTER AMENDMENT.

ATTORNEY LIMBIAN RESPONDED THAT HE DOESN'T READ THE CONSTITUTIONAL PROVISION IN ARTICLE IX THAT IT REQUIRES A YES VOTE. HE DOESN'T BELIEVE THE LEGISLATORS HAVE TO VOTE YES ON THE CHARTER AMENDMENT.

COUNCILMAN HUGHES ASKED WHAT WOULD HAPPEN IF THEY VOTED NO, AND NOT MOVED IT ALONG.

ATTORNEY LIMBIAN STATED HE IS UNCERTAIN AS HE HAS NOT SEEN EVIDENCE OF IT HAPPENING BEFORE, BUT HE WILL RESEARCH IT.

COUNCILWOMAN DAVIS STATED SHE WOULD LIKE CLARITY, AS SHE WAS TOLD IN THE PAST THEY WERE REQUIRED TO VOTE ON CHARTER AMENDMENTS, MOVING IT TO BALLOT.

ATTORNEY LIMBIAN ADDED AFTER READING ARTICLE IX OF THE OHIO CONSTITUTION, THAT IT IS HIS VIEW TO MOVE IT ALONG IT REQUIRES THE PETITIONS AND A YES VOTE OF THE LEGISLATURE. HE SUGGESTED THAT COUNCIL TABLE THE MATTER AND HE'D RESEARCH IT FURTHER.

COUNCILWOMAN DAVIS NOTED THAT HER CONCERN IS THAT THE GENERAL PUBLIC HAS THE RIGHT TO PUT IT ON THE BALLOT WITHOUT THEIR CONSENT. SHE'D LIKE CLARIFICATION.

COUNCILMAN RAY STATED THAT IT PREVIOUSLY WAS EXPLAINED THAT IF THE CRITERIA IS MET AND VALID, THEN COUNCIL IS DUTY BOUND TO FORWARD IT.

COUNCILWOMAN DAVIS MENTIONED THAT IF IT WAS TABLED, SHE DOESN'T KNOW IF THERE IS ENOUGH TIME TO MOVE IT TO BALLOT.

ATTORNEY LIMBIAN STATED THAT THERE MIGHT BE AN ABILITY FOR IT TO GO TO THE BOARD OF ELECTIONS WITHOUT A YES VOTE. BUT WITH THE SEPARATION IN POWERS, HE DOES NOT THINK THAT ANYONE COULD TELL THEM THEY HAVE TO VOTE ON ANY PIECE OF LEGISLATION IN A CERTAIN WAY.

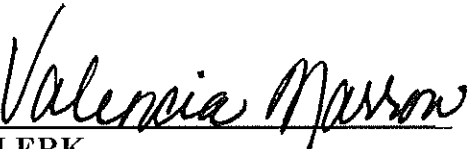
