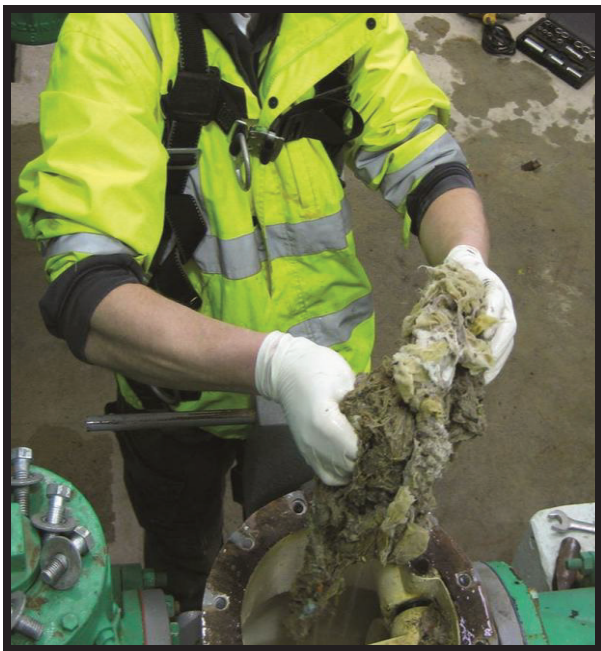


PLEASE DON'T FLUSH WIPES DOWN THE TOILET!

The label might say, “flushable,” “disposable,” “sewer and septic safe,” or “biodegradable.” It makes no difference, because wipes can still clog your toilets and possibly cause a sewer backup into your home. They also cause us problems at the wastewater treatment plant, our sanitary lines and storm lines.

We often see items such as sanitary wipes, diapers, feminine hygiene products, dental floss, wads of hair, toys, food waste and grease, cigarette butts, and other debris in our sewer system. Please don't flush these items.
