Question: Were there an excessive number of speeders in Youngstown School Zones? **Answer:** In a five day period there was in excess of 35 THOUSAND violators.

Question: Where are the cameras located? **Answer**: All school zones throughout Youngstown will eventually have photo speed enforcement. January 17th we will start issuing warnings, Enforcement starts on February 17th.

Phase one includes:

Chaney HS on S. Hazelwood Ave
Kirkmere ES on Kirk Road
Rayen Early College MS on Williamson Ave
Saint Christine School on S. Schenley Ave
Volney Rogers ES on S. Schenley Ave
East HS (2 zones) on Bennington Ave & East High Ave
Woodrow Wilson (2 zones) on Gibson St. & East
Indianola Ave.
Stambaugh Charter on Hazelwood Ave

Question: What are the hours of enforcement? **Answer:** Hours of enforcement will be one hour before school starts and until 6PM during school days. Each school also has REDUCED SPEED times twice a day and the posted speed will be enforced whenever children are likely to be present.

Question: How fast do I have to drive to get a citation?

Answer: During REDUCED SPEED times (morning and evening) you will be cited at 6MPH over the posted speed. Durning the remainder of the day you will be cited at 11MPH over the posted speed.



Question: How much are the fines?

Answer: Depends on your speed. Violations

range from \$100.00 to \$150.00
