YOUNGSTOWN HEALTH DIRECTOR'S ORDER
March 23, 2020

**In re: Restricted Access to City of Youngstown Building At 20 Federal Place,
Youngstown, Ohio, 44503.**

**Non-Essential Employees and the Public are excluded from City of
Youngstown Building - 20 Federal Place, Youngstown, Ohio, 44503.**

In an effort to protect the public and employees, I, Erin M. Bishop, Health Commissioner of the City of Youngstown, pursuant to the authority granted to me in R.C. 3701.13 to "make special orders... for preventing the spread of contagious or infectious diseases...",

Order the City of Youngstown Building - 20 Federal Place at 20 Federal Street, Youngstown, Ohio 44503 restricted effective March 23, 2020 at 11:00 pm until and upon further review and written notice.

I make this Order to avoid the imminent threat with a high probability of widespread exposure to COVID-19 with a significant risk of substantial harm to a large number of people in the general population, including the elderly and people with weakened immune systems and chronic medical conditions.

Effective 11:00 p.m. March 23, 2020, any operations or business being conducted at the City of Youngstown Building - 20 Federal Place at 20 Federal Street, Youngstown, Ohio 44503 will be reduced to essential employees. Employees who can perform their job duties remotely will be instructed by their Department Head to do so and must remain away from the building until further order. There will be no public access to the City of Youngstown Building - 20 Federal Place including, but not limited to, private and publicly held corporations and other business entities.

All employees who are not working must be following the Ohio Department of Health Director's Stay at Home Order. Please continue to follow prevention techniques as recommended by the Center for Disease Control (CDC) and Ohio Department of Health (ODH): Practice proper handwashing, proper sanitizing of surfaces and social distancing of 6 feet if you must leave the house. This shall remain in effect until further notice.
