As part of the City of Youngstown’s ongoing lead mitigation effort, the Water Department will be sending notification to approximately 11,000 customers whose direct service lines may contain lead, galvanized materials or are an unknown status. **This does not mean that there is lead present in the water supply.** The notifications are part of a mandate by EPA’s Lead and Copper Rules revision to identify and notify customers of any potential risk of lead exposure based on aging service lines produced prior to 1954.

The City of Youngstown has begun to remove or replace lead and galvanized service lines utilizing EPA financing working towards the 2037 EPA mandate and will continue to identify service line materials for removal or replacement.
