Notice is hereby given that the City of Youngstown (City) has prepared its FY 2026 Annual Action Plan (AAP) for its housing and community development programs in accordance with federal regulations at 24 CFR Part 91. The FY 2026 AAP outlines how the City intends to expend its entitlement grants of \$3,263,748 in Community Development Block Grant (CDBG) Program funds, \$395,891.10 in HOME Investment Partnerships (HOME) Program funds, and \$287,089 in Emergency Solutions Grant (ESG) Program funds. The FY 2026 AAP covers the program period from July 1, 2026, to June 30, 2027.

The FY 2026 AAP contains the following major components:

1. Identification of federal and non-federal resources reasonably expected to be made available during FY 2026 to undertake activities identified in the approved Five-Year Consolidated Plan for FY 2025-2029.
2. A list of activities to be undertaken during FY 2026 to address community development and housing needs, including the geographic distribution of activities to be completed.
3. Identification of homeless and special needs activities to be undertaken during FY 2026 to address identified needs within the City.

The proposed FY 2026 AAP will be available for public review and comments for 30 days from May 18 to June 17, 2026, on the City's website <https://youngstownohio.gov/> and in the City's Community Development Division office located at 26 South Phelps Street, 4th Floor, Youngstown, Ohio 44503

The City will hold a public meeting to solicit comments on the FY 2026 AAP on June 4, 2026, at 5:00 P.M. at the Public Library of Youngstown & Mahoning County, 305 Wick Ave, Youngstown, OH 44503. Persons interested in the use of the above identified funding sources are encouraged to attend the public meeting and provide oral or written testimony.

The City of Youngstown will make reasonable accommodations and services necessary for sensory-impaired and disabled citizens at the public meeting.
